<b>Program Name:</b>	<b>ASHI Basic Wilderness First Aid</b>
<b>Intended Audience:</b> Community and Workplace	Everyone who participates in wilderness activities and wants to know what to do in an emergency. Volunteers and professionals who lead groups on short trips in relatively low-risk situations, where they are not far from help.
<b>Prerequisites:</b>	None
<b>ASHI-approved Training Materials:</b>	Wilderness Emergency Care
<b>Recommended Initial Instruction Time:</b>	8 hours
<b>Recommended Renewal Instruction Time:</b>	About half of Initial Instructional Time
<b>Maximum Student-to-Instructor Ratio:</b>	20:1
<b>Student-to-Equipment Ratio:</b>	Varies with equipment available
<b>Successful Completion: (Certification)</b>	<b>Performance Evaluation:</b> Can reasonably perform skills/scenarios without continuous assistance.
<b>Card Issued</b>	<b>Basic Wilderness First Aid certification card</b> with Basic Wilderness First Aid checked
<b>Certification Period:</b>	Up to 3 years

<b>Program Name:</b>	<b>ASHI Wilderness First Aid</b>
<b>Intended Audience: Community and Workplace</b>	Wilderness trip leaders and guides. People who participate in more extended wilderness trips.
<b>Prerequisites:</b>	None
<b>ASHI-approved Training Materials:</b>	Wilderness Emergency Care
<b>Recommended Initial Instruction Time:</b>	16-20 hours
<b>Recommended Renewal Instruction Time:</b>	8 -10 hours
<b>Maximum Student-to-Instructor Skills Ratio:</b>	10:1
<b>Student-to-Equipment Ratio:</b>	2:1 for bandaging skills. Students should be encouraged to bring outdoor equipment they would have on trips to improvise splints.
<b>Successful Completion: (Certification)</b>	<b>Performance Evaluation:</b> Can reasonably perform skills/scenarios without continuous assistance
<b>Card Issued</b>	<b>Basic Wilderness First Aid certification card</b> with Wilderness First Aid checked
<b>Certification Period:</b>	Up to 3 years

<b>Program Name:</b>	<b>Wilderness First Responder</b>
<b>Intended Audience:</b> Community and Workplace	Trip leaders and guides/ professional rescuers / workplace response team members / persons planning extensive wilderness trips
<b>Prerequisites:</b>	Professional Rescuer CPR (may be integrated).
<b>ASHI-Approved Training Materials:</b>	ASHI Wilderness Emergency Care
<b>Recommended Initial Instruction Time:</b>	60-80 hours
<b>Recommended Renewal Instruction Time:</b>	30-40 hours
<b>Maximum Student-to-Instructor Skills Ratio:</b>	10:1
<b>Student-to-Equipment Ratio:</b>	2:1 (1:1 Student-to-manikin recommended for CPR)
<b>Successful Completion: (Certification)</b>	<b>Written exam:</b> Required (80% or better). <b>Performance Evaluation:</b> Can reasonably perform skills/scenarios without assistance
<b>Card Issued</b>	<b>Advanced Wilderness certification card</b> with Wilderness First Responder checked
<b>Certification Period:</b>	Up to 3 years

<b>Program Name:</b>	<b>Wilderness EMT Upgrade</b>
<b>Intended Audience: Community and Workplace</b>	Urban EMT's with an interest in or need for instruction in wilderness emergency care
<b>Prerequisites:</b>	Emergency Medical Technician – Basic (if desired, the EMT Wilderness upgrade may be integrated into an EMT Program). Other medical professionals may take the course for the training (and CE's if they are available from the provider) but only participants certified as EMT-B, EMT-I, OEC-T, or EMT-P are eligible for the WEMT certification.

<b>Recommended Initial Instruction Time:</b>	40 hours
<b>Recommended Renewal Instruction Time:</b>	20 hours
<b>Maximum Student- to-Instructor Ratio:</b>	10:1
<b>Student-to- Equipment Ratio:</b>	2:1
<b>Successful Completion: (Certification)</b>	<b>Written exam:</b> Required (80% or better). <b>Performance Evaluation:</b> Can reasonably perform skills/scenarios without assistance
<b>Card Issued</b>	<b>Advanced Wilderness First Aid card</b> with EMT Upgrade checked
<b>Certification Period:</b>	Up to 2 years
